#### 19. Programme Summary:

The Department of English(SF) conducted a Bridge Course in Basic English Grammar for all the I year students of all the UG(SF) departments, from 06.09.2021 to 09.09.2021. Basic Grammar such as Parts of Speech, Tenses, Active & Passive Voice, Sentence Pattern and Direct & Indirect Speech were taught to the students in order to prepare them to get ready for college curriculum and to enable them to understand basic English grammar so as to make both Tamil and English medium students be confident in listening to lectures in English. All the basic grammar topics were planned and scheduled for four days.

All the UG(SF) students were divided into four groups according to the class strength. The classes were conducted through Google Meet. For each group, a separate Google classroom was created. The classes were scheduled between 9.30 am and 3.30 pm, consisting of five hours. Every day, the last hour was used to evaluate the students. The students were asked to fill up Multiple Choice Questions, using Google Forms, 17 e-Contents(videos) had been prepared and uploaded in College Website and in YouTube channel for students' use. In addition to video contents, PPTs and Word Docs were created for the benefit of the students. All the staff members of English(SF) coordinated the course successfully.

#### A REPORT ON THE BRIDGE INTENSIVE COURSE -2018

#### 29-06-2018

The main objective of **The Bridge Intensive Course in English** is to initiate English to the first year students of the degree course. It has been observed over the years that students who join the degree course face a lot of difficulties in learning their curriculum through the English language.

In the globalized world it has become mandatory for the undergraduates to pursue their education in English, in order to struggle worldwide. Even to seek jobs in India, effective communication and a good knowledge in English is a fundamental requirement.

The Department of English conducted a Bridge Intensive Course from 25<sup>th</sup> June to 28<sup>th</sup> June 2018 to make the students familiar with the essential rudiments of English grammar and introduce them to the new medium i.e. English.

The total number of students benefitted under this course was 1111. The students were divided into **TWELVE** batches as given below:

The course was planned in such a way that out of the five hours a day, the first four hours were dedicated for teaching basic doctrine of English grammar. The last hour was utilized to test the extent to which the students had learnt the grammar subject which was taught in the class that day by conducting a written test. In each hour, one aspect of English grammar was trained intensively. Inclusive study materials written in simple and logical style by the faculty members were given to the students, for their easy understanding. Bilingual method of teaching was adopted by the teachers in the class. Every nuances of grammar was taught with ample illustrations. The students were eager to raise doubts and questions and they were clarified and answered by the teachers in a persuasive way. Participatory learning was widespread all the way through the course.

The question papers for the test were prepared in such a way to test the understanding level of the students. Feedback about the relevance and usefulness of the course was collected at the end which will help the department to identify students who need remedial classes and others who need classes at the higher level for better employment opportunities.
